

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

*WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern*

PLACEMAT A ASSEMBLY: Refer to **DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- Sew together (1) **A** 10" square, (1) **D** 1-1/2" X 10" strip, and (1) **C** 3-1/2" X 10" rectangle to create **PLACEMAT CENTER A**. Square to 10" X 14", make (3).

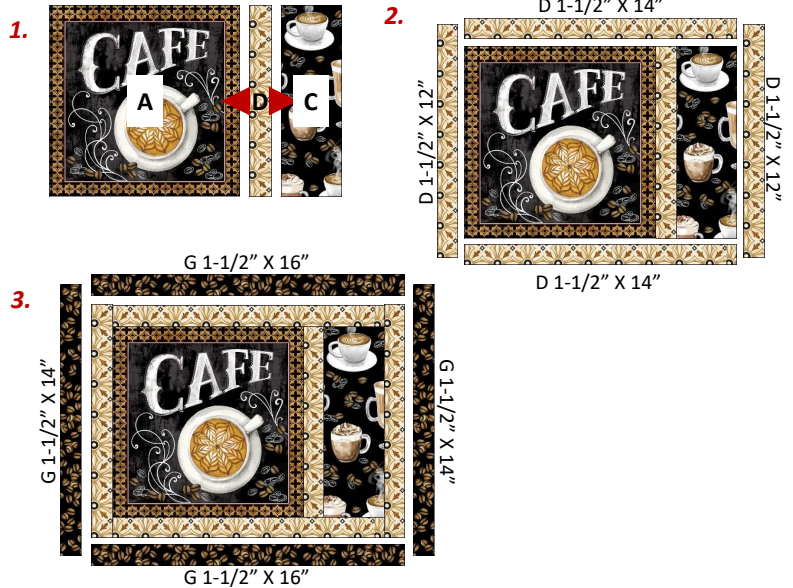
BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

- Sew (1) **D** 1-1/2" X 14" strip to top and bottom of **PLACEMAT CENTER A**, then sew (1) **D** 1-1/2" X 12" strip to each side.
- Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" X (16") strip to top and bottom, then sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" X (14") strip to each side.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **H** fabric.

PLACEMAT B:

Repeat all steps using the following fabrics, make (3).

CENTER: **A - J - B**

BORDER 1: **J**

BORDER 2: **F**

Bind with fabric **E**.
